


## Regulation

1. The “Professor Ruy de Albuquerque Prize”, referred to below as “Prize”, has been established by Professor Ruy de Albuquerque’s family, by the Faculty of Law of the University of Lisbon and by the law firm Albuquerque & Associados.
2. The “Prize” is awarded for research work in the field of Law, including the History of Law and the Philosophy of Law.
3. The purpose of the “Prize” is to promote legal scholarship and research, and in particular to offer undergraduates in their final year and recent graduates the chance to experience legal work, and legal practice in particular, at closer hand.
4. The panel of judges appointed will each year identify the preferred area of study to be chosen from among those mentioned in paragraph 1, above [sic].
5. Applications are invited from law undergraduates in their final year, law graduates and holders of Master’s degrees in law, aged 25 years or less, of Portuguese nationality, residing in Portugal, or who have obtained a degree or postgraduate qualification from a Portuguese higher education institution.
6. Trainee lawyers and lawyers employed by Albuquerque & Associados may not compete for the “Professor Doutor Ruy de Albuquerque Prize.”
7. The work presented must be original, written in Portuguese, with a brief abstract in English and/or French, and shall be typed in “Word” format, in Times New Roman, font size 12, with 1.5 spacing and covering no more than 200 pages.
8. Entries for the “Professor Ruy de Albuquerque Prize” shall be delivered to Rua Victor Cordon, nº 21, 1200- 482, Lisbon, by 1 January each year, or may be sent by post to the same address to arrive no later than 19.00 hours on the same date.
9. The entries shall be assessed by a panel of judges, deciding by majority vote, consisting of lawyers of established reputation and doctors of law selected by a board comprising two partners of Albuquerque & Associados, two members of the Academic



Council of the Lisbon Faculty of Law, chosen by the said Faculty, and also a member of Ruy de Albuquerque's family.

10. The value of the award shall be set annually by the Jury, at a minimum of €25,000 (twenty five thousand euros), and shall be financed by sponsors of national prestige to be selected by the Board referred to in paragraph 9. The winning entry shall be published in the journal of the Faculty of Law of the University of Lisbon, or issued in monograph form by a specialist publisher.

11. Albuquerque & Associados shall bear all costs of the "Prize", namely administrative expenses, including remuneration for the judges assessing the entries.

12. The "Prize" shall also consist of a 24-month traineeship at Albuquerque & Associados on the same terms as other lawyers at the partnership, which may be followed, if the candidate is interested, by a further traineeship, of a duration to be agreed, at the offices of a foreign law firm with which Albuquerque & Associados maintains a professional relationship, dependent, however, on positions being available at such firms.

1 – If the winner is a senior student, the traineeship shall be performed after the degree course; however, remunerated short-term traineeship periods before the end of the degree course, to be performed during holiday periods, may be agreed to on a complementary basis.

2 – "Senior student" shall be defined as a student attending the next to last year of the degree course, with no failed/incomplete subjects.

13. In exceptional cases, traineeships, as mentioned in the previous paragraph, may be offered to other candidates in addition to the prize winner.

14. The Prize shall not be granted "ex aequo."

15. The prize shall not be awarded in the event that the appointed judges agree, by majority vote, that none of the entries for the award have met the academic standards required for publication.

16. The award shall be presented at a public ceremony to be held at the Faculty of Law, University of Lisbon, or at a place indicated by the Board referred to in paragraph 9.

17. Any omissions in these Regulations shall be resolved by the Board, which shall state due grounds.

18. The competition shall be advertised in no less than two national newspapers, expressly naming the sponsors and indicating the website where the regulations may be consulted.

19. This regulation will be available at the websites of the Lisbon Faculty of Law ([www.fd.ul.pt](http://www.fd.ul.pt)) and Albuquerque & Associados ([www.albuquerque-associados.com](http://www.albuquerque-associados.com)).

20. An Honour Committee shall be established, presided over by individuals of national prestige, whose composition shall be the responsibility of the Board.
